1. From North (M90)

Take the M90 southbound from starting point following signs for the Forth Road Bridge and Edinburgh. Two miles before the bridge, the road becomes the A90, which will carry you across the bridge and beyond for about 5 miles to the outskirts of Edinburgh. Follow signposts for the City Centre continuing straight ahead as the road becomes Queensferry Road. At the fifth set of traffic lights Queensferry Road bears right which you should follow. Continue ahead for about 2 miles until you cross Dean Bridge.

After the bridge at the traffic lights take the first left turn onto Randolph Crescent, then first left again onto Great Stuart Street. At the mini roundabout at the end, turn right then follow traffic flow right again then slightly left onto Ainslie Place. Continue straight on at lights as the road becomes Queen Street. After 500m turn right at lights onto Frederick Street. No 51a is the black door 50m up hill on the left adjacent to the Aga Shop.

2. From West (M8)

Take the M8 towards Edinburgh through busy commercial and residential areas. Bear left at junction where Gorgie Road (A71) becomes Dalry Road (A70) and continue (following signs for City Centre) for 0.5 miles. At busy Haymarket junction bear right onto West Maitland Street (One Way) keeping in central lane and continue straight ahead for 0.5 miles, as the road becomes Shandwick Place, to the next set of traffic lights. All cars must turn next left onto South Charlotte Street, straight ahead through Charlotte Square and down North Charlotte Street. At the bottom, again all cars must turn right onto Queen Street. Continue straight ahead for about 500m and turn right at lights onto Frederick Street. No 51a is the black door 50m up the hill on the left adjacent to the Aga Shop.

3. From West (M9)

Follow the M9 towards Edinburgh exiting at Junction 1. Turn left onto A8 (Glasgow Road) and follow signs for Edinburgh City Centre continue straight ahead for 1.7 miles. Continue straight on at lights for 0.5 miles and then straight on at roundabout (2nd exit) onto St Johns Road. Continue straight on through built up areas toward City Centre on the A8 (various road names) for 1.7 miles, bearing slightly left at the Haymarket Junction, straight onto West Maitland Street and Shandwick Place to the West End. After the Traffic Lights all cars must turn next left onto South Charlotte Street, straight ahead through Charlotte Square and down North Charlotte Street. At the bottom, again all cars must turn right onto Queen Street. Continue straight ahead for about 500m and turn right at lights onto Frederick Street. No 51a is the black door 50m up hill on the left adjacent to the Aga Shop.

4. From East (A1)

Follow the A1 to the outskirts of Edinburgh passing a large Asda on the left hand side as you approach a mini roundabout, take the second left and then take the first left at the next roundabout, (the road is still the A1 and follow signs for city centre). Head straight over the first roundabout and through one set of traffic lights, the road bends to the right, stay in the right hand lane and go straight on through the traffic lights onto Willowbrae Road. Continue along Willowbrae Road (passing a Tesco Metro petrol station on your left) to the junction of London Road and turn left at the traffic lights. Stay in the right hand lane at the next set of lights and carry straight on, you will pass Meadowbank Stadium on your right as you continue up London Road, through two sets of lights and at the third set stay in the right hand lane and take the right hand fork, still named London Road (changing from A1 to B1350).

Continue straight on through one set of lights which will take you to a large roundabout at the top of Leith Walk, take first left at the roundabout, then passing the Playhouse Theatre on your left, take the second left at the next large roundabout, immediately get into the left hand lane to head through a set of traffic lights along York Place. Pass straight on through four sets of traffic lights, (York Place becomes Queen street) and approach the 5th set in the left hand lane to turn left into Frederick St. 51a is the black door 50m up the hill on the left adjacent to the Aga Shop.

5. From South (M74 then A702)

Exit the M74 at junction 13 onto the A702 towards Biggar and Edinburgh. Remain on this road for approximately 40 miles. Upon reaching the outskirts of Edinburgh you should cross the A720 City Bypass. Continue following the road straight ahead on the A702 (Biggar Road) towards the City Centre for 1.7 miles. The road changes name to Comiston Road, Morningside Road, Bruntsfield Place, Leven Street and then Home Street as you reach the end of the A702. Bear left at the busy Tollcross Junction onto the A700 (Earl Grey Street) and continue straight on passing four sets of traffic lights on to the end of Lothian Road. At the end, turn right; then all cars must turn left onto South Charlotte Street, then continue straight ahead through Charlotte Square and down North Charlotte Street. At the bottom, again all cars must turn right onto Queen Street. Continue straight ahead for about 500m and turn right at lights onto Frederick Street. No 51a is the black door 50m up the hill on the left adjacent to the Aga Shop.

6. Parking

On street parking is available close to the office. Rates vary between 40-45 pence for 15 minutes with a maximum stay of 4 hours (3 hours on George Street). Tickets are obtained from machines on the street. They only accept silver coins and do not give out change. Alternatively you can pay by mobile phone by registering in advance at www.mpark.com. Tickets must be displayed clearly as wardens are ruthless.

The closest locations to our office are; Thistle Street, Hill Street, George Street, Queen Street (South side only), Queen Street Gardens West, and Heriot Row.

7. From Waverley Train Station

By foot (15 Minutes)

Exit the station via either roadway ramp both sides of the main concourse onto Waverley Bridge. Turn right and proceed to the end of the street. Turn left onto Princes Street and continue straight ahead for 450m passing the Scott Monument and the Royal Scottish Academy to your left. Turn third right onto Frederick Street staying on the right hand side. Continue straight to the top of the street, cross George Street and continue down Frederick Street for 50m. 51a is a black door on the right adjacent to the Aga Shop.

By Taxi

There are many Black Taxis to be found close to the station concourse. It should be a five-minute journey costing no more than a few pounds.

8. From Edinburgh Airport

Airport Taxi

Exit the terminal building and turn left continuing straight ahead for 30 metres where the airport taxi rank is located. The journey time is around 20-25 minute although allow extra time during morning rush hour. Cost should be around £15 depending on journey time.

Airlink Bus

Exit the main terminal building and turn left towards the covered walkway. The Airlink bus stop is 50m up the walkway and is clearly signposted. Tickets can be purchased on board from the driver. Fares are £3 single and £5 for an open return. The journey time takes 25 minutes and there are departures every 10 minutes from 7am until 10pm although the service is 24 hour.

The bus makes several stops along the route terminating at Waverley Station which would be most convenient. From here it is a short 15 minute walk. Directions for this are given above.

Car Hire

Most of the major car hire companies are represented. Their desks can be found in to the domestic arrivals area.
